Our research on the 1920 season uncovered eight errors contained in various baseball sources, including the "official home run log", used to compile home runs both hit and allowed. Shano Collins (Chi-AL) played 12 games in the outfield, not Eddie Collins. Guy Morton (Cle) allowed 2 home runs, not the 0 reported in some sources. Dutch Leonard (Det) actually gave up a homer that was charged to Red Oldham on 8/20. Lynn Brenton (Cin) actually gave up a homer that was charged to Dutch Reuther on 9/9. Tom Zachary (Wash) gave up a homer that was charged to Joe Gleason on 9/11. Hal Carlson (Pitt) gave up a homer that was charged to Jimmy Zinn on 9/18. Ira Townsend (Bos-NL) gave up the homer that was charged to his brother, Leo, on 9/25. Shovel Hodge (Chi-AL) gave up a homer that was charged to Red Faber on 10/1. These corrections were given to sources at Stats, Inc. and SABR and will be corrected in future editions of their reference material. Many thanks to Retrosheet and SABR for all their help and research with the 1920 season boxscores.

Please use Gavy Cravath of Philadelphia (NL) primarily as a pinch hitter.

For most realistic league play, when possible, allow only the pitchers preceded by an asterisk to start once every four games (3 game rest between starts.) All other starting pitchers should start once every 5 games (4 game rest between starts).

For those players whose error ratings exceed the advanced fielding chart, use the maximum advanced error rating. When playing super advanced use the listed rating. For example, a player with a super advanced rating of 71 at 2b becomes 41 in the advanced game.
